NW Hall of Fame

Purpose of Committee:

- 1) Receive nominations to the Hall of Fame and recommend to the Council, people who have been nominated and who meet the approved criteria for selection to the NW Regional Hall of Fame.
- 2) Shall meet at the annual meeting of the NW Council.
- 3) Shall be limited to a maximum of the 4 best candidates submitted each year.

Submission of Nominees:

- 1) September 1st of each year shall be the deadline for submitting nominations.
- 2) Nominations must be submitted on the NW Hall of Fame application and accompanied by two letters of recommendation.
- 3) It is mandatory that all nominations be accompanied with detailed information and newspaper clippings.

Review of Candidates:

The committee will receive for review all candidates and information in October.

Selection:

The committee will meet at the annual National Council Meeting to finalize the selections.

Categories and Criteria

- 1) Player (three points needed for selection)
 - a) All Star Team
 - b) MVP Award
 - c) Recognition Award
 - d) Home run, batting or defense award
 - e) Regional participant (5 years equals one point)
 - f) National Championship participant (2 years equal one point)
- 2) Umpire (thirty points needed for selection)
 - a) 10 years local association membership (2 points)
 - b) Each Regional Tournament worked (2 points)
 - c) Each Regional Tournament worked as UIC (3 points)
 - d) Each National Championship Tournament worked (3 points)
 - e) Each National Championship Tournament worked as UIC (5 points)
 - f) Assistant UIC at Regional or National Tournament (4 points)

Note: Requirements: Must have umpired 15 years, and inactive 2 years from National Championship tournaments.

- 3) Manager or Sponsor (five points needed for selection)
 - a) 20 or more local seasons (5 points)
 - b) 2-5 Regional Tournaments (2 points)
 - c) 1-2 National Championship Tournaments (2 points)
- 4) Commissioner
 - a) 10 years of service
 - b) Nominee shall have served in some of the following areas:

Regional Director

Chairman or Vice-Chairman of a National Committee Host of a National or Regional Tournament classified 'Major' or 'A' Special Recognition

- 5) Meritorious Service
 - a) This category includes Individuals or organizations which offer any combination of the above categories. Candidates can be an organizer, bidder, years of service, financial contributor etc. Non player candidates may still be an active participant.
